

TVET Access Courses 2009

TVET 'access' courses are the same as 'mainstream' TVET courses, but are run separately for a smaller class of High School students with learning support needs.

The TAFE Teacher will usually teach less course units, and focus on the practical skills needed for entry level jobs. For some units, you may be given "RT" for Received Tuition, which indicates that although you were not able to achieve all the competencies, you attended and participated. You will certainly still gain your units for the HSC with RT results.

Horticulture

Learn the gardening skills for working in a plant nursery, or in a garden maintenance team. 35 hours of work placement.

Cleaning Operations (*Asset Maintenance*)

Use the right equipment & cleaning agents for surfaces, windows, furniture and outdoor surfaces. Occupational health and safety rules are followed.

Furniture

Use hand and power tools to make a coffee table, chair, CD rack or chessboard, for example! Learn the skills and safety practises for trade assisting work.

Retail

Learn to operate retail equipment and organise stock and displays for shop assisting and stores work. Customer communication and problem solving are important for all jobs. 35 hours of work placement.

Hospitality Operations

Learn practical skills in food preparation, customer service, cleaning, and hygiene for the commercial food industry. 35 hours of work placement.

Animal Care

Students will learn to feed, handle and groom animals, maintain their housing and equipment, and do some basic first aid.

Car Detailing

Students are in the TAFE Automotive Section, learning to safely clean vehicles with the right equipment and agents to the standard for dealerships and car rental agencies.
